## House Republicans Preview Budget Priorities

**RICHMOND, VA** – This afternoon House Republicans discussed various budget priorities for the 2012-14 biennium. Delegate Steve Landes (R-Augusta) and Delegate S. Chris Jones (R-Suffolk), both members of the House Appropriations Committee, discussed house budget plans for economic development and health and human services spending, respectively.
